TIME: Field Events - 4:30pm, Running Prelims - 5:30pm (100, 110M Hurdles, Section 1-3, 200 Meter Run, 200 Meter Dash), Finals - 7pm.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 please send by the Wednesday before the meet.

ADMISSION PRICES: Adults \$3-Students \$2

ENTRY LIST: All entries will be made on the Direct Athletics site. Questions about the entry process should be directed to the help section of Direct Athletics. Remember you may enter 3 contestants per event. The roster created for this meet may be used in the Piatt-Macon, and Freshman-Sophomore Invitational, and Boys Okaw meet hosted by MHS.

Enter 3: Reminder you may enter up to 3 in all individual events.

ORDER OF EVENTS: will be sectional meet order. An exhibition Distance Medley (800, 400, 1,200, 1,600) will be run at 4:45pm. This event counts as 1 of the 4 allowed events per athlete.

MEET SCORING: This is a non-scored event.

AWARDS: Medals for 1st and 2nd places in individual events and 1st in relays Ribbons for 2-8 in relays and 3-8 in individual events

UNIFORMS: Note should be taken of the Track and Field Rules in regard to uniform requirements and the IHSA rulings. No locker or shower facilities will be provided.

REST ROOMS: are available in two locations on the Sports Complex.

CONCESSION STAND: will be available during the meet.

TRACK FACILITY: An all-weather track with metric events. Concrete throwing rings and discus cage are used both have been relocated for the benefit of the soccer program. Only 1/4'' or shorter spikes are permitted.

ABSOLUTELY NO TAPE: Any contestant using tape of any type on the track or runways will be DQ'ed.

GENERAL REMINDER: Please instruct your contestants to report when field events are called. Running events as always take preference over field.

FACILITY USAGE: The track area is in use for class work until 3:30 each day. Please do not arrive before that time. Camps are to be set up on the west side or north of the track only. RULES FOR FIELD EVENTS: Four (4) trials with no finals. Five alive in Pole Vault and High Jump Starting heights will be determined by entries.

RUNNING PRELIMS: 100 meter, 110 meter high hurdles, 200 meter (8 to finals). Heat winners and next best times advance. Should the FAT timer fail in any heat 100th of seconds on manual time will be used to advance heat placers.

ALL OTHER RUNNING EVENTS: will be run in sections against time.

FOUR EVENTS: are the maximum permitted under I.H.S.A. rules

BUS PARKING: Busses may park along Kratz Road. No busses inside the fence. Officials only will be allowed to park inside the fence.
